The following request was sent out on 4/30/2021 by Minister (Community Affairs), Embassy of India, Washington DC:

The most critical items for India are the following:

- 1. Oxygen concentrators.
- 2. Oxygen cylinders with 10 litres or 45 litres LMO (Liquid Medical Oxygen) capacity
- 3. Oxygen generation plants: detailed specifications and requirement may also be provided. Further, it may be indicated whether technical person/s will be sent to help in installation of such plant.
- 4. Remdesivir
- 5. Tocilizumab
- 6. Ventilators/BIPAP

The Government of India has waived customs duty and health cess on imported items. In order to clear customs expeditiously, we ask that that consignment include

- Airway Bill,
- the Commercial invoice,
- the List of items carton-wise, and
- the Donation / Gift certificate.

The consignments will be sent directly to the Indian Red Cross Society, who will receive consignments on behalf of the Government of India.
